A Legacy in Pulmonary Medicine

Considered a “Father of Pulmonary Medicine,” Thomas L. Petty, MD, Master FCCP, is a recognized leader in pulmonary and critical care medicine. His legacy includes:

- ▶ Spearheading the Nocturnal Oxygen Therapy Trials (NOTT), the outcomes of which are still used today as the scientific foundation for oxygen therapy in patients with COPD.
- ▶ Establishing the Aspen Lung Conference Endowment Fund, financing the annual meeting where leading clinicians and researchers discuss clinical problems and research in lung disease.
- ▶ Founding the National Lung Health Education Program (NLHEP) to promote the early detection and treatment of COPD.

Dr. Petty is the former Head, Division of Pulmonary Medicine and the former Director of the Fellowship Training Program for the University of Colorado. Through his years of dedicated service, he has mentored many of the current leaders in pulmonary medicine. He has been

an outstanding contributor to the ACCP for nearly 4 decades. He will forever be known as a pioneer in research and treatment for respiratory conditions and for improving care of patients with respiratory diseases.
